DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apply Safer's Vegetable Garden Insecticide Hose-End Spray using the hose-end applicator provided (attached). Applicator will accurately dilute this concentrated insecticide for treatment of vegetables, flowers, fruits, shrubs and trees.

1. Read the complete label for application instructions and precautions.
2. Connect spray applicator provided to garden hose.

3. Remove bottle cap and attach bottle to applicator.
4. Turn ON/OFF switch on top of the applicator to OFF position (sideways).
5. Turn on water tap.
6. When ready to spray, point sprayer toward target and turn ON/OFF switch to centre ON position.
7. When spraying is completed, turn ON/OFF switch to OFF position, then turn water off. Disconnect applicator from water hose.

CAUTION: Rate of delivery of product will vary depending on water pressure, location, time of day, length and diameter of hose, etc. Complete contents of container (550 mL) can be sprayed in approximately 2-4 minutes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For control of aphids, caterpillars (cabbage looper, imported cabbageworm), leafhoppers, earwigs, beetles (asparagus beetle. Colorado potato beetle), whitefly on vegetables: Spray insects to wet when they first appear. Insects must be sprayed directly to achieve proper control. Repeat 10-14 days later if required. May be used on vegetable crops up to the day before harvest. Wash vegetables before using.

CROPS PROTECTED: Asparagus, beans, cabbage, cauliflower, celery, cucumber, eggplant, lettuce, peppers, potatoes, radish, tomatoes.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Product may cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not apply to blossoms or when temperatures exceed 28 deg. C. This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container or applicator. Dispose of applicator and empty container in household garbage.
