DIRECTION FOR USE

Bacteria control: initial dose: 20-80 mL per 1,000 mL of water in total system. Maintenance dose: every 1-5 days or as needed 4-80 mL per 1,000 litres of water in system. For bacteria control, in industrial water supply systems, treat with 4-80 mL per 1,000 litres of water entering the system.

NOTE: Product should not be used in water intended for drinking or food preparation.
