DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

When applied as a clean up spray when trees are dormant, DORMANT OIL controls overwintering Leafroller, Pear psylla, San Jose scale, European scale, Lecanium scale, European Red mite, Blister mite, Rust mite and Currant Aphids on apples, pears, plums, prunes, cherries, currants, gooseberries, ornamental trees and shrubs. Do not use on Beech, Butternut, Colorado Blue Spruce, Douglas Fir, Hickory, Holly, Sugar Maple, Japanese Maple, Walnut and Delicious variety of apple. Mix 20 mL (4 teaspoonfuls) in 1 litre of water and mix thoroughly.

COMBINATION DORMANT SPRAY: DORMANT OIL can be used in combination with Lime Sulphur for use on fruit trees, roses and deciduous ornamentals for control of overwintering insects (eggs), Oyster Shell Scale, San Jose Scale, Rose Scale, black scale as well as overwintering fungus disease. Mix 40 mL (8 teaspoonfuls) of Lime Sulphur plus 20 mL (4 teaspoonfuls) of DORMANT OIL in 1 litre of water.

TIMING: USE ONLY WHEN TREES ARE DORMANT. Apply in early spring when danger of frost is past, before leaf buds show green at tips. Wet all parts of trees thoroughly but do not overspray. Spray on a mild morning to allow the mixture to dry quickly. Do not spray during freezing weather.

MIXING AND APPLICATION: Fill spray half full with water, then add the recommended amount of DORMANT OIL. Finish filling the tank with water and mix thoroughly. The mixture should turn milky white indicating good emulsification. Do not use if the product does not emulsify or if emulsion breaks. Prepare fresh spray emulsion before each use. Do not store diluted spray. Hand sprayers should be shaken from time to time. A coarse spray is better for penetration than a fine spray nozzle. Thorough coverage is essential for good results. Spray to point of run-off. Respraying or overspraying can cause damage. If you are not familiar with a dormant oil spray or in doubt, consult your Local Government Horticulturist for specific instructions.
