TREE DRESSING is specially formulated to aid the healing of pruning cuts, grafts, and wounds on woody plants and trees. Use TREE DRESSING to give wounds and cuts a protective coating which will prevent an excessive loss of sap and guard against the entry of woodboring insects.

PRUNING CUTS: Always cut branches as close as possible to the main limb or trunk without leaving any stub. Stubs do not draw sap and cannot heal properly. Heavy branches should first be roughly cut some distance from the trunk to release the weight; then make a neat cut near the trunk.

TREE WOUNDS: All injuries should receive prompt treatment to prevent infection. Neatly trim jagged breaks or abrasions and clear away all dead or diseased portions of wood or bark.

APPLICATION: It is essential that the surface to be treated

is free of loose bark and dirt. Then apply a heavy coating of TREE DRESSING. If the sap from a wound causes a blister, puncture to release sap, and apply a new coat of TREE DRESSING. GREENLEAF TREE DRESSING can also be applied to cover grafts and tree surgery.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not thin TREE DRESSING with gasoline or solvent as this will cause injury to bark.
