Whiteflys: These tiny mothlike insects can be found throughout the year on the undersides of leaves on indoor plants and throughout the growing season on outdoor plantings. Repeat applications at two week intervals as required to control the scale-like larvae hatching from eggs. May be used up to day of harvest.
