PURPOSE: Sergeant's Rug Patrol Flea Killer spray contains residuals and is specifically formulated for spot treatment of carpets and broadloom. Spray affected areas as needed. A repeat treatment is usually necessary in 1 to 2 weeks if reinfestation occurs. Also kills ants, carpet beetles, cockroaches, earwigs, millipedes, silverfish, spiders and brown dog ticks.

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE CAN WELL. Hold can upright, approximately 30 cm from surface being sprayed. Test a small inconspicuous area of carpet for color fastness. Apply evenly and spray until wet. Spot treat carpets and broadloom where pests may be present. If reinfestation occurs, repeat application. Treat your pet with Sergeant's flea and tick products before allowing access to treated areas. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM TREATED SURFACE UNTIL DRY. PROVIDE ADEQUATE VENTILATION AFTER INDOOR USE.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat or store at temperatures over 50 deg C. Do not spray near flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands after use. DO NOT USE ON HUMANS, PLANTS, ANIMALS, FOODSTUFF, FOOD UTENSILS, FISH BOWLS OR ANIMAL FEED AREAS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOODSTUFFS. Do not use in any area where food may be exposed. Do not use in bulk food storage areas. Do not use in cupboards where food or cooking utensils are stored. In home or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food or cooking utensils before spraying. Thoroughly wash all surfaces that might contact food before re-use.

FIRST AID: Contains volatile petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes, seek medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then discard with household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
