DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apply Q-111 to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelain and bedframes with a cloth, or mop so as to thoroughly wet surfaces.
