For use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control insects listed on front panel.

INDOOR USE: Thoroughly treat cracks, crevices, baseboards, underneath furniture and equipment, around garbage containers, refrigerators, sinks and stoves. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before reuse. Do not use in areas where food is stored. In meat and food processing plants and food service establishments, treat only when plant is NOT in operation. Remove or cover all food packaging materials, and utensils and cover all food processing surfaces before spraying. After treatment, wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse thoroughly with potable water before resuming operations. Do not use in rooms where milk is processed, handled or stored. Do not store or spray near open flame or stove.

OUTDOOR USE: Spray outside surfaces of screens and around doors and window frames, foundations, patios, light, fixtures and other places where insects may alight, or congregate and enter.

DIRECTIONS: Hold container approximately 30 cm. from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications produce a coating which will vapourize into cracks and crevices for insect control. If reinfestations occur, repeat applications as necessary. Provide adequate ventilation after indoor use. **KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM SURFACE UNTIL DRY.**

PRECAUTION: **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not spray near open flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. **DO NOT USE ON HUMANS, PLANTS, ANIMALS, FOOD STUFF, FOOD UTENSILS, FISHBOWLS OR ANIMAL FEED AREAS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY.**

FIRST AID TREATMENT: Contains volatile petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately. Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. In case of contact with the skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes, get medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then dispose of in accordance with provincial regulation. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DISPOSAL

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.

4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
