PULP and PAPER Process B-1035 is recommended for the control of bacterial and fungal slime in the production of paper. POINT OF ADDITION: Process B-1035 should be added at a point in the system to insure uniform mixing such as the Beater, Hydro-pulper or Fan or Broke Storage Pump. DOSAGE: Apply 0.05 to 0.5 kgs of Process B-1035 as supplied per tonne (dry basis) of pulp or paper produced, as a slug dose. If needed repeat daily. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment. One litre of PROCESS B-1035 = 1.023 kg.

FIRST AID:

Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove immediately to fresh air. If not breathing apply artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give

oxygen. Call a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

TOXICOLOGY:

Probably mucosal damage may contra-indicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
