**WEEDS CONTROLLED:** Bedstraw, Black Medick (Yellow Clover), Buttercup, Chickweed, Clover, Creeping Charlie (Ground Ivy), Dandelion, Dock, English Daisy, Hawkbit (fall dandelion), Heal-All, Knotweed, Narrow-leaved Plantain, Ox-eye Daisy, Plantain, Poison Ivy, Ragweed, Sandwort, Shepherd's-Purse, Speedwells, Stonecrop.

Note: 1 square metre = approx. 10 sq. ft.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Apply Wilson Lawn WeedOut® Attach & Spray Concentrate using the hose-end applicator attached. It will accurately dilute this concentrated weed killer for treatment of 500 m<sup>2</sup> (5375 square ft.) of lawn area.

**READ THE COMPLETE LABEL FOR APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS PRIOR TO USE.**

1. Shake container thoroughly, then attach to garden hose.
2. Turn water supply on at the source. Water pressure will build in hose since the sprayer is already in the "OFF" position.
3. To apply product, bend safety tab and turn the control valve clockwise to the "ON" position.
4. For best results, hold sprayer and bottle level, and direct sprayer in a sweeping side-to-side movement. Spray the contents of bottle (1.25 litre of product) evenly over 500 m<sup>2</sup> of lawn. For smaller areas, spray at the rate of 100 mL over 40 m<sup>2</sup>. Do not overlap areas already sprayed.
5. To spray water only, turn the control valve clockwise so that the valve indicator arrow is pointing to the "WATER" position on the sprayer.
6. When spraying is complete, turn the control valve to "OFF" position. Turn water off. Disconnect hose from applicator and store product in original container.

DO NOT APPLY THE SPRAY SOLUTION OR ALLOW SPRAY TO DRIFT ONTO DESIRABLE TREES, SHRUBS, VEGETABLE GARDENS OR FLOWER BEDS. Apply in May, June or September when weeds are growing actively. Repeat applications may be required for some species.

**PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:** Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves.

**APPLICATION FREQUENCY:** For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

**RE-ENTRY INTERVAL:** Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

**OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS:** Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Reuse gloves for pesticide application only.

**PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Avoid inhaling spray mist. Do not apply in very hot, very dry or rainy weather. Do not apply to newly-seeded lawns until after third mowing. Do not use on bentgrasses. Do not cut grass for several days after application. Do not water within 24 hours of application. Do not use clippings from a freshly sprayed lawn as mulch.

**FIRST AID: If in eyes,** flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. **If on skin,** wash thoroughly with soap and water. **If swallowed,** call poison control centre or get medical attention IMMEDIATELY. Take container label or product name and P.C.P. Reg. No. with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and dispose of empty container in household garbage.
