DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Lawns: SPOT APPLICATION ONLY

Application can be made by hand with a shaker can.

For control of Earwigs – Apply 20 g per m² in areas of infestation only.

Lawn Moths (Sod Webworm), Pillbugs, Sowbugs and Springtails (Collembola) – Apply 7.5 to 15 g per m² in areas of infestation only.

Chinch Bugs – Apply 20 g per m² in areas of infestation only. Water lightly before and after treatment.

Ants: Spot treatment in lawns, gardens, patios, driveways, etc.: Ant hills – Apply 3 grams (5 mL spoonful) of granules over and around each individual ant hill. Digger Wasps – Apply 3 grams over and around each individual ground nest opening. Make application about dusk, when the wasps are not active.

Lawns: BROADCAST APPLICATION

White grub suppression (such as European Chafer and Japanese Beetle larvae): When sampling indicates that white grub larvae are feeding in the root zone apply 900 g per 100 m² of lawn. Do not use in areas where the thatch is more than 3 cm thick. For grub control apply any time between late July and early October.

Application can be made by using a fertilizer spreader. Following application, brush the lawn to ensure penetration of the granules on the soil surface. Thoroughly water the product into the lawn after application. Repeat application as necessary.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be fatal if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and inhalation of dust. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food or feed. Use only as recommended on label. When applying to lawns wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks and chemical resistant (e.g.rubber) gloves during handling, application and watering-in. Rinse gloves before removal. Do not treat areas greater than 450 m² (5000 sq.ft.) in one day. Keep people off treated lawns for 24 hours following application and watering in.

FIRST AID: If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, rinse with water for 15 minutes. If irritation develops, consult a physician. If swallowed, induce vomiting by giving 1-2 glasses of water and touching the back of the throat with a finger or a blunt object. Call a doctor or Poison Control Centre immediately. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Diazinon is an cholinesterase inhibitor. Note to physician: Stomach lavage. Antidote: atropine sulphate at 1-2 mg. every 15 minutes may be necessary.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap empty container and discard with household garbage.
