Greenhouse Use (on Ornamental, tomatoes, peppers and cucumbers). May be used against Two Spotted Spider Mites, Aphids, Greenhouse Whitefly, Sweetpotato whitefly, mealybugs, earwigs.

Outdoor Use (Ornamentals, trees, shrubs, flowers, fruits and vegetables). May be used against Two Spotted Spider Mite, Aphids, Whitefly, Sweetpotato whitefly, mealybugs, earwigs, soft brown scale, rose and pear slugs (sawfly larvae), elm leaf miner.

Mix with water one part concentrate to <u>17</u> parts of water. *Shake well before use*. Spray thoroughly both sides of the foliage and stems. The insects must be covered with spray. Safety to all varieties of ornamental plants has not been determined. Test spray on a few plants before using on the whole crop. Spray once every two weeks, or as needed, based on monitoring of pest populations.

USE PRECAUTIONS: When treating a plant cultivar for the first time, spot treat a portion of the cultivar, and wait at least 24 hours to see if any phytotoxic symptoms develop, before treating an entire group of plants.
