CONTROLS: Aphids, mealybugs, spider mites, whitefly, soft brown scale, pear psylla, rose or pear slugs and earwigs on fruits and vegetables.

DIRECTIONS: Made of selected soaps that kill insects on contact. Insects must be sprayed directly to achieve proper control. Spray thoroughly both leaf surfaces and stems. For aphids and mealybugs repeat as required. For whitefly spray at 2 week intervals. For spider mites apply once weekly 2-3 times. Spray other pests upon sighting. Can be used right up to day of harvest.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Concentrated soap may cause eye irritation. Avoid eye contact. Wash fruits and vegetables before using.

DISPOSAL: Rise container and dispose of in household garbage. Do not use empty container.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, wash with plenty of water.
