DIRECTIONS: Blend 1 part by weight of WARFARIN 0.5% CONCENTRATE POWDER with 19 parts by weight of a suitable bait. Rolled oats, cracked corn, corn meal, and canary seeds are good products to use in a dry bait for regular service work.

WARFARIN 0.5% CONCENTRATE POWDER can also be blended with vegetables, fruit and meat to make a bait where rodents are feeding on specific foodstuffs.

WARFARIN 0.5% CONCENTRATE POWDER contains a yellow dye to change the appearance of the finished bait so that it will not resemble the original food.

RATS: Place blended bait in amounts of 100-450 g in locations frequented by rats or where rats have been known to feed. Baits must be protected from pets, poultry, livestock, etc. by tamper-resistant bait boxes or other suitable means. Baits should be examined regularly and replenished before completely eaten. Replace moulding or decomposing bait.

MICE: For controlling mice, blended bait amounts of 10-30 g should be placed in each location. Follow the same general direction as for rats. Mice are more difficult to control than rats and complete control may take a longer period of baiting.

For areas not directly related to food processing: Use only in non-food or non-feed areas where feed, food, packaging and handling equipment are never opened or exposed.

For areas where feed or food is processed, served or stored: In meat and food processing plants (processing areas) use only when plant is not in operation. Remove or cover all food, packaging material and utensils before placing bait in baiting stations. Remove all baits and dead rodents before reuse of the plant (processing areas include storage and service).

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. Store in a dry place away from food or feed. Avoid inhalation of the powder. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash arms, hands and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds.

FIRST AID: WARFARIN is an anti-coagulant chemical which, if taken accidentally by humans, domestic animals or pets, may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and haemorrhage may result. **If in eyes,** flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. **If on skin,** wash thoroughly with soap and water. **If swallowed,** give patient one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with a finger or blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Vitamin K₁ in the form of intravenous, intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case, measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times, will determine the appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of unused or spoiled bait in accordance with local requirements. Follow provincial instructions for any required cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For more information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

RODENT DISPOSAL: Dispose of dead rodents in garbage or by burying.
