Sprout-Nip Solution is formulated for application as a mist or fog to inhibit sprouting of potatoes in storage. It can be used with mechanical or thermal generators. Potatoes to be treated must be firm and free from excessive dirt or other debris. Mechanically damaged potatoes cannot be treated until suberization is complete, a process which normally takes 2-3 weeks or more.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Seal the potato storage building to prevent or reduce escapes. Adjust the ventilation system to ensure even distribution of moving air. Adjust the application equipment to deliver droplets in the rage one to ten microns. Apply sufficient Sprout-Nip Solution to achieve a deposit on the potatoes in the range 3 to 12 p.p.m. Shut off the ventilation system for 48 hours after treatment is completed.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS: Irritating to lungs during application

- 1. Prolonged application with thermal generators may cause fires. Remove all flammable material from the vicinity of the application point before operations commence. Keep at least two operational fire extinguishers suitable for use in confined spaces at the point of application. Do not leave equipment unattended during operation.
- 2. The fog from this product is irritating to lungs. Wear a nose mask fitted with a filter if it is necessary to enter the storage building during application or before the fog has settled after application.
- 3. This product will inhibit sprouting of potatoes used for seed. Do not apply on or near potatoes to be used for this purpose. Do not store potatoes to be used for seed in treated buildings.
- 4. Low doses of this product will cause internal sprouting. Potatoes stored adjacent to treated potatoes may develop internal sprouts.
