DIRECTIONS; Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings as damage may occur. Home Pest Control Spray will control many household and area pests. Apply as a coarse spray or paint brush application to infested places such as in crevices, cracks, exposed surfaces, behind and around areas where insects hide, (cabinets, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, water pipes and tanks). Apply to area where insects can gain entry into households such as around window and door frames and sills and along baseboards adjacent to them. Repeat if reinfestation occurs.

FOR DWELLINGS AND INFESTED AREAS; For control of Cluster Fly, Clover Mite, Carpet Beetles, Earwigs, Ant Crickets, Fleas,

Cockroaches, Brown Dog Ticks, Silverfish and Sow Bugs spot treat infested areas where needed. Do not apply to animals or humans. Change bedding after treatment.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Keep away from heat and open flames. Do not use near or in areas where food, food products, feed or cooking utensils are stored. Do not use in any area where food may be exposed. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before spraying. Thoroughly wash all surfaces that might contract food before reuse. Solvent used in product is a petroleum distillate. Avoid spraying plastics, asphalt and rubber materials. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not reuse container. Dispose of empty container in household garbage.

FIRST AID; Contains Petroleum Distillates. If swallowed DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Obtain medical attention immediately. If in eyes, flush with fresh water and obtain medical attention. If on skin, wash with soap and water.

TOXICOLOGY; Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
