- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 250 mL per 100,000 L.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of super-chlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 1 L of algaecide concentrate per 100,000 L.
