C-I-L House and Garden Pressurized Spray controls flying and crawling insects.

#### DIRECTIONS

Remove protective cap. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Press button and hold can upright while spraying. Spray directly at insects.

HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: Flying Insects: Flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps. Before spraying close doors and windows. Direct spray to all parts of room. Spray 5-10 seconds for each 30 m<sup>3</sup>. Open door 15-30 minutes after spraying. Crawling Insects: Cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders. Contact insects directly with spray. Direct spray into cracks, crevices and recesses behind cabinets, sink, stove, etc. Repeat when necessary.

NOTE: When spraying for flying or crawling insects avoid contamination of food, utensils, and surfaces that may contact food. Remove pets from area to be sprayed.

Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles: Clean garments before spraying. Spray garments thoroughly, particularly folds and seams, so that insects are directly contacted. Spray interior surfaces of

storage areas. Repeat monthly if articles not stored in moth-tight containers. For rugs and carpets use on concealed areas, under furniture, in corners and around baseboards. Avoid use on furs, rayons, silk or satin materials.

GARDEN INSECTS: Kills insects on contact such as Caterpillars, Japanese Beetles, Red Spiders, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Mites and Leaf Hoppers. For use on outdoor plants such as Roses, Dahlias, Azaleas, Salvia, Chrysanthemums, Asters, Marigolds, Gladiola, Delphiniums, Begonias, Iris, Snapdragons, evergreens and deciduous plants and on indoor plants such as English Ivy, African Violets, etc. Spray plants lightly in one second bursts from a distance of 60 cm. For best results spray early in morning or evening when the air is still. Avoid heavy wetting. Hit all visible insects with spray and cover both top and bottom of leaves. Repeat when necessary. Do not spray on Lantana or Maidenhair Fern. Use with caution on tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants in direct sunlight or when temperature exceeds 32 deg C.

PRECAUTIONS: Avoid inhaling spray mist or contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid contamination of food, feed, utensils, drinking water or any body of water. Wash thoroughly after use. Keep nozzle 1 m from objects to avoid staining. Do not puncture or store at temperatures above 50 deg C or in direct sunlight. Do not throw into fire or incinerator. Do not spray into or near any open flame.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty container with household garbage.
