Purpose of Application

The purpose of this application was to include additional rotational crops (canola and lentils) on the Armezon Herbicide label.

Chemistry and Environmental Assessments

Chemistry and environmental assessments were not required for this application.

Health Assessments

Toxicology and occupational exposure assessments were not required for this application.

No residue chemistry data were provided and none are required with the application to support the amendments to the rotational crop restrictions on the label. Based on the available information, the amendments to the crop rotational indications for Armezon Herbicide (guarantee: 336 g a.i./L topramezone), can be supported from a food residue chemistry perspective. Given that no further amendments have been proposed to the already registered crops and use directions/restrictions, dietary exposure to topramezone is not expected to increase and will not pose an unacceptable health risk to any segment of the population, including infants, children, adults and seniors.

Value Assessment

The information provided in support of the addition of canola and lentils as rotational crops in the year following Armezon Herbicide application was found to be supported. Canola and lentil are important crops for many Western Canadian producers. Having canola and lentil as rotational crops on the Armezon Herbicide label provides value to growers in that it provides flexibility for herbicide re-cropping management.

Conclusion

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency has completed an assessment of the information available and supports the amendment to the product label for Armezon

Herbicide.
