Background

The original source of Rival Technical Herbicide (trifluralin) was first registered in 1984.

Purpose of Application

The purpose of this application is to register a new source by the current registrant and new specifications or manufacturing process for Rival Technical Herbicide, a currently registered manufacturing concentrate product that is intended for use in the manufacture of end use products.

Chemistry Assessment

Common Name: Trifluralin

The chemistry requirements for Rival Technical Herbicide have been completed.

Health Assessments

The active ingredients produced at the new and registered sites of manufacture of Rival Technical Herbicide are chemically equivalent. Therefore, the health risk profile of Rival Technical Herbicide is expected to be similar to that of the original registered source and no toxicological data were required.

An occupational exposure assessment was not required as the use pattern, including host crops, application rates and timings remained unchanged.

A dietary exposure assessment was not required as there were no increases in contaminants of toxicological concern or a significant change in the guarantee of the active ingredient.

Environmental Assessment

An environmental assessment for Rival Technical Herbicide were not required as it is used only in the manufacture of an end use product, and since assessment was conducted on the technical grade active ingredient.

Value Assessment

A value assessment is not required for a manufacturing concentrate.

Conclusion

The PMRA has completed an evaluation of the subject application and has determined that Rival Technical Herbicide is eligible for registration.
