Background

RoConTM Concentrate Rodenticide (Mustard seed powder 10.89%; α -olefin sulfonate, sodium 6.91%, Reg. No. 27400) formerly named EXIT CONCENTRATE RODENTICIDE is registered in Canada for the control of the Richardson's Ground Squirrels (*Spermophilus richardsonii*).

Purpose of Application

The purpose of this application is to add Norway rats (*Rattus norvegicus*) to RoConTM Concentrate Rodenticide label.

Chemistry Assessment

A chemistry assessment was not required since there was no change to product chemistry. Health and environmental assessments were not required since the use pattern and application rates of the component product remained unchanged.

Value Assessment

Three efficacy trials, one laboratory and two fields conducted in Canada (BC and SK) and China showed that RoConTM Concentrate Rodenticide can control Norway rats. The label expansion for RoConTM Concentrate Rodenticide to include control of Norway rats is supported.

Conclusion

The PMRA has completed an evaluation of the subject application and has found the information adequate to support the label expansion for RoConTM Concentrate Rodenticide.
