4'-OH bifenthrin and TFP acid

Details: Aerobic soil and water/sediment studies examining the transformation of the

isomers for bifenthrin are required.

Title: Other Studies/Data/Reports

Details: A bioaccumulation monitoring program is required to assess the potential for

bioaccumulation under Canadian use conditions.

PART 9 ENVIRONMENTAL TOXICOLOGY

Title: Other terrestrial invertebrates

Details: A study which determines the residual toxicity for non-target arthropods and

the potential for re-colonisation is required.

Title: Bioaccumulation – tissue residue based acute and chronic fish toxicity studies

Details: Both acute and chronic fish studies which quantify the residues in fish at test

termination are required.

Details: Biomagnification and bioconcentration studies for fish and aquatic

invertebrates are required.
