### **Purpose of Application**

The purpose of this application was to amend the grazing statements on the Engarde 25 SG Herbicide product label.

### **Chemistry, Environmental and Value Assessments**

Chemistry, environmental and value assessments were not required for this application.

#### **Health Assessments**

An acceptable scientific rationale was submitted to support amendment of the grazing statement on the label of Engarde 25 SG Herbicide. Exposure to residues of rimsulfuron in the diet from this action will not pose health risks of concern to any segment of the population, including infants, children, adults and seniors.

Toxicology and occupational exposure assessments were not required for this application.

#### Conclusion

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency has completed an assessment of the available information and has found it sufficient to support the amendment to the grazing statement on the Engarde 25 SG Herbicide product label.
