



## Evaluation Report for Category B, Subcategory 3.10 Application

### Purpose of Application

The purpose of the subject application is to include the label amendments that are listed below:

- (1) Add the general tank mixing statement as per the published PMRA Guidance Document – Tank Mix Labelling.
- (2) Include additional tank mixing statements to accompany the general tank mixing statement above.
- (3) Remove the following uses:
  - Triazine tolerance canola as a host crop
  - Lexone Herbicide as a tank mix option
  - Charge Adjuvant as a tank mix option
- (4) Update the following tank mix options:
  - Agral 90 to be replaced with a generic term non-ionic surfactant
  - Sethoxydim 184 g/L to be replaced with Poast Ultra Herbicide for post-emergent weed control in canola, flax, and soybean.
  - Basagran to be replaced by Basagran Liquid and Basagran Forte for post-emergent weed control in soybean
  - Sencor formulations to be replaced by Sencor 480 F for weed control in potatoes

### Chemistry, Health and Environmental Assessment

Chemistry, health, and environmental assessments were not required as there was no change to product chemistry, product formulation, or use pattern.

### Value Assessment

A thorough review of the label determined that the addition of the general tank mixing statement is acceptable as it is consistent with the requirements in the PMRA Guidance Document – Tank Mix Labelling (March 16, 2023).

The inclusion of the general tank mixing statement on the label allows growers greater flexibility to select tank mixtures to control pests in labelled crops. Flexibility in the selection of tank mix partners may contribute to resistance management practices, integrated pest management

programs or the control of a broader range of pests, with associated cost- and time-savings by the user.

Other label amendments, including additional tank mix statements, update on tank mix options, and removal of a host crop, were supported based on submitted rationales and relevant registrations.

## **Conclusion**

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency has completed an assessment of the subject application and has found the inclusion of the general tank mixing statement on the Venture L Herbicide label is acceptable.
