### **PART 9 ENVIRONMENTAL TOXICOLOGY**

**DACO** 9  
**Title** Environmental Toxicity

**Details:** The applicant submitted waiver requests for the waiver of some of the environmental toxicology data. This rationale is conditionally acceptable (see below).

The applicant must conduct a feeding study with the end-use product (DACO 9.6.4) in the laboratory to determine if birds would consume the micro-flakes presented as food. Observations on the toxicity or other sublethal effects of the EP on the birds must also be reported. If the results indicate that the micro-flakes are consumed by the test birds, then a limited scale monitoring study conducted under conditions of operational use in a SBW control program may be required.
