Purpose of Application

The purpose of this submission was to register a new manufacturing concentrate (MA), Ally Extra MUP, containing a registered source of the active ingredients metsulfuron-methyl, tribenuron-methyl, thifensulfuron-methyl under the Importation for Manufacturing and Export Program (IMEP).

Chemistry Assessment

Ally Extra MUP is formulated as granules containing thifensulfuron-methyl at 27.3%, metsulfuron-methyl at 10.9%, and tribenuron-methyl at 13.6%. This manufacturing-concentrate product has a density of 0.66-0.73 g/mL and pH of 7.3-8.0. The required chemistry data for Ally Extra MUP have been provided, reviewed and found to be acceptable.

Health Assessments

Ally Extra MUP is considered to be of low acute oral, dermal and inhalation toxicity. This manufacturing-concentrate is a potential eye irritant and a potential skin sensitizer.

Environmental and Value Assessments

Environmental and Value assessments were not required for this application.

Conclusion

The Pest Management Regulatory Agency has completed an assessment of the information provided and has found the information sufficient to support the registration Ally Extra MUP.
