DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Using conventional methods of application, deposit 3.0% to 5.05
(as received) based on the weight of fabric being treated.

PRECAUTION:

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Avoid contamination of food.
Harmful if swallowed. Avoid getting product in eyes or on skin.
In case of contact flush with water.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated
clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20

minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. In case of contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
