**PRECAUTIONS**

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

**Corrosive. Causes eye damage and severe skin burns. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants and chemical-resistant gloves when handling this product. Avoid contamination of food. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.**

## FIRST AID

**If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin IMMEDIATELY with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or physician for treatment advice.

**If Swallowed:** Call a poison control centre or physician IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or physician. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is recommended that compatibility be checked in the individual formulations.

Typical applications and suggested concentrations are:

<u>Aqueous Product to be Protected</u>	<u>Amount of CANGUARD BIT 20 DPG Preservative (Based on Total Weight of Product)</u>
Latex Emulsions	0.03-0.075%
Aqueous Based Coatings	0.03-0.25%

For latex emulsions and aqueous based coatings, CANGUARD BIT 20 DPG Preservative is to be used as an in-can preservative during storage and as a preservative during the manufacturing process. It is not for post manufacture protection.

## DISPOSAL

1. Triple rinse or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the
