DIRECTIONS FOR USE: APPLY THIS PRODUCT AS IT IS PURCHASED. DO NOT MIX WITH WATER OR OIL. Use trigger spray attachment enclosed. Apply in May, June or September when weeds are growing actively. Do not water for 24 hours. Rain within 6 hours reduces effectiveness. Spray acts within a few days and weeds gradually die. Grass fills in as weeds disappear. Some weeds may require up to 4 weeks for complete kill. Repeat application in 3-4 weeks may be required for some species. Do not apply in very hot, very dry or rainy weather. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns until after the 3rd mowing. This product is only effective when applied to the leaves of actively growing weeds. This product will not prevent new weeds - **apply only when weeds are present**. This product is designed to target treatment of weedy areas of lawns. DO NOT apply to any body of water. DO NOT contaminate irrigation/drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product will harm other broadleaved plants in the vicinity of the treatment area. If applying this product using a handheld sprayer, do not directly spray or allow the spray to drift onto ornamentals or gardens. Do not spray exposed roots of trees and ornamentals. Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty. DO NOT apply to driveways, sidewalks or any other hard surface.

CONTROLS (in alphabetical order): Bedstraw, Black Medick (Yellow Clover), Buttercup, Chickweed, Clover, Dandelion, Devil's Paintbrush, English Daisy, Ground Ivy (Creeping Charlie), Heal-All, Knotweed, Narrow-leaved Plantain (Ribgrass), Plantain, Poison Ivy, Ragweed, Shepherd's Purse, Wild White Clover.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF TRIGGER SPRAYER:

EASY SET UP

1. Remove sprayer from holder. Gently pull tubing.
2. Remove seal from top of cap. Remove plug from cap.
3. Securely snap the plug on end of tubing into hole on cap.
4. Remove plastic tab to activate batteries.
5. Twist nozzle to adjust spray from CLOSE to SPRAY to STREAM.

HOW TO USE

- A. Aim toward target weeds and away from people and pets.
- B. Press the trigger to spray.
- C. Release the trigger to stop spray.

After use: 1. Twist nozzle completely to CLOSE position. 2. Secure sprayer upright in holder. 3.

Failure to adjust nozzle completely to CLOSE position and properly secure sprayer in holder may result in leakage and damage to property or injury to people or animals.

To replace batteries: 1. Slide battery compartment door to unlatch and open. 2. Remove used batteries and insert new AA batteries *in correct positions* as marked per diagram inside of battery compartment. Never insert the positive end where the negative end belongs and vice versa. Always use a complete set of new batteries of the same type when replacing batteries. **Never** mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries. 3. Securely close battery compartment door. 4. **Always** follow manufacturer's recommendations for use and disposal of batteries.

Additional Operating Notes: •Do not submerge in water. •Before each use, inspect sprayer carefully. Make sure hose is flexible and not kinked, worn or cracked, and that all connections

are tight. •When storing sprayer for prolonged periods remove batteries. NOTE: Trigger sprayer is to be used only for this product.

MAXIMUM APPLICATION FREQUENCY: For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

REMEMBER ... ALWAYS STORE PESTICIDES, CAPS, SPRAYERS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS: Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. After treating, wash thoroughly. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash contaminated skin thoroughly and shower. Launder contaminated clothing separately before reuse.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL: Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

PRECAUTIONS: Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapours or spray mist. Harmful to some desirable plants. Avoid spraying flowers, shrubs, vegetables and fruit crops. Bentgrass may be injured. Do not store container near seeds, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. KEEP FROM FREEZING.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: TOXIC to birds, small wild mammals, aquatic organisms and non-target broad leaf terrestrial plants.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Reg. No. with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Remove batteries and dispose of accordingly. Discard empty container in household garbage. Unused or partially used products should be disposed at provincially or municipally designated hazardous waste disposal sites.
