RESTRICTED USE: NOTICE TO USER: This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label. The user assumes the risk to persons or property that arises from any such use of this product.

NATURE OF RESTRICTION: For sale only to pest control operators, farmers and to persons authorized in government approved pest control programs where the vendor maintains a record of sales, including name, address and signature of the purchaser together with the quantity of the product purchased.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: PRO® POISON CORN is a whole corn, which has been impregnated with Strychnine. However, it should not be exposed to rain or snow. If bait is to be placed in unsheltered areas, covered feeding stations should be used.

Pigeons: For the control of feral pigeons on farms, place PRO® POISON CORN Ready-to-Use Bait in and around buildings where pigeons are known to congregate or in feeding stations. Treatment area must be checked daily for dead carcasses and spilled bait until the control program is completed. Dead carcasses, uneaten bait and collected spilled bait must be disposed of by incineration or burial in a pit no less than 46 cm (approximately 18 inches) deep and then covered to prevent scavengers from unearthing carcasses.

For the control of feral pigeons in urban areas, place PRO® POISON CORN Ready-to-Use Bait on buildings or ledges where pigeons are known to congregate at least 2 metres (approximately 6 feet) off the ground. Treatment area must be checked daily for dead carcasses and spilled bait until the control program is completed. Dead carcasses, uneaten bait and collected spilled bait must be disposed of by incineration or burial in a pit no less than 46 cm (approximately 18 inches) deep and then covered to prevent scavengers from unearthing carcasses.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. This product should be stored away from children under lock and key. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Empty containers and all grain fragments must be burned or buried deeply. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers, other persons, pets or domestic animals. Wear chemical-resistant gloves, a dust mask, long pants and a long-sleeved shirt during mixing/loading, application, clean-up and other handling activities. Baits should be placed in areas inaccessible to children, pets, wildlife and domestic animals or in tamper-resistant bait boxes. This product is toxic to wildlife. Treated seeds exposed on soil surface may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Bury dead pests; do not leave where carnivores might have access to them. Toxic to all forms of life.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: This product is toxic to wildlife. Exposed treated grain is hazardous to non-target birds and other wildlife. All carcasses and uneaten bait must be disposed of by incineration or burial in a pit no less than 46 cm (approximately 18 inches) deep enough to prevent scavengers from unearthing carcasses. Toxic to all forms of life. **DO NOT USE IN AREAS WHERE PEREGRINE FALCONS ARE KNOWN TO NEST OR HUNT.**

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Obtain medical attention immediately. Consult a poison control centre for detailed information on treatment for strychnine poisoning. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and immediately flush with large amounts of water for 15 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Wash exposed area of skin with soap and water.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Central nervous system stimulant. Convulsions may occur within 5 to 10 minutes of ingestion.

If the person is fully conscious and not convulsing a few moments after the ingestion, immediate ingestion of activated charcoal has been proven beneficial. Keep the patient in a warm, dark room with minimal sensory stimulation. Postpone gastric lavage until the patient is fully premedicated to control further convulsions or seizures. Artificial respiration may become necessary. Keep patient under continual observation until convulsions and reflex irritability have been suppressed and gastric lavage can be performed safely.

STORAGE OF UNUSED BAIT: The unused bait can be stored in its original container and keeps its killing effect. It is not affected by heat or cold.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For more information on the disposal of unused product contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

Carcasses Disposal (Pigeons and Non-target species): All carcasses must be disposed of by incineration or burial in a pit no less than 46 cm (approximately 18 inches) deep and then covered to prevent scavengers from unearthing carcasses.
