FLYING INSECT KILLER III is designed for use in the Cañon Spring Action type automatic dispenser. The automatic dispenser releases a metered dose of 55 mg. of insecticide every 15 minutes. Each can contains enough product to protect an area of at least 170m³ of free flow air space for up to 30 days.

DIRECTIONS: Remove protective cap from top of can and insert can into special automatic dispenser. Place dispenser 2 to 3 meters above floor at a point where air flow will carry insecticide throughout the area. Do not install directly over food or food packaging surfaces.

IN MEAT PACKAGING PLANTS: Spray only when the plant is not in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials may be kept in the room. Cover food handling equipment. Any treated surfaces that may contact meat food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use for meat processing.

PRECAUTIONS: CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Container may explode if heated. Do not expose to temperatures above 50°C. DO NOT SPRAY NEAR OPEN FLAME OR SPARK. Do not puncture or incinerate. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin and inhalation of spray mist. Wash after using. Contents toxic to fish and birds. Do not contaminate food, feed or water. Do not install directly over polished, plastic or varnished surfaces. DO NOT USE IN DWELLINGS OR SCHOOLS. In hospitals, DO NOT USE IN NURSERIES OR ROOMS WHERE INFANTS, ILL OR AGED PERSONS ARE CONFINED.

FIRST AID: If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If accidentally swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
