DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use in feed mills, food processing plants, food service establishments, food storage and food transportation vehicles.

Kills on contact exposed stages of fruit flies, flies, mosquitoes, cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, moths, cadelle, confused flour beetle, granary weevil. To control flying insects apply in undiluted form with a fogging

applicator or vaporizer.

Surface Treatment:

To control crawling or running insects such as cockroaches, silverfish, confused flour beetles, etc., use at the rate of 5 litres per 100 m². Spray thoroughly all cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Store in a cool place - do not freeze. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use near fire or open flame. Avoid skin contact and inhalation of spray mist. Wash after using.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill.

FIRST AID:

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
