**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacturing of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

**PRECAUTIONS:** PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Highly corrosive to the eye and skin. Potential skin sensitizer. May be fatal if swallowed. DO NOT get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling this product. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust and fumes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
