DIRECTIONS: FURNACE UNIT: Add 5 mL into tray. PORTABLE UNIT: Add 25 mL for every 20L of water added to pail. Use each time reservoir is refilled. Rinse out monthly. NOTE: To remove lime and scale deposits in reservoir, empty tank and use RO-TYME Humidifier De-scaler and Cleaner.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Wear rubber gloves when handling this concentrate.

FIRST AID: If splashed in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If splashed on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
