FIRST AID

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Carbofuran is a reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use oximes such as 2-PAM. Start by giving 2 mg. atropine intramuscularly. According to clinical response, continue until sign of atropinization occur (dry mouth or dilated pupils). If in eye, instill one drop of homatropine.
