#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of rodenticide baits which are registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT, and not for use as an end-use product.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND OTHER UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Avoid inhaling dust. Product can be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wear respirator, eye goggles, chemical resistant gloves and appropriate chemical safety clothing when handling, mixing or loading the concentrate. Wash arms, hands and face with soap and water after mixing or handling product and before eating, drinking, or smoking. Harmful or fatal if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water and separate from other laundry before reuse.

Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided. Repeated exposure to small amounts of this product can produce accumulative toxicity. Persons at risk should have their prothrombin times checked periodically.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate municipal water systems, lakes, streams or ponds by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

#### FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

#### **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:**

If swallowed, absorbed or inhaled by humans or domestic animals, the administration of Vitamin  $K_1$  in the form of intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion, as indicated in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses, are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

#### STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place away from food, feed, seed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.
