For paper, pulp and board mill addition use 0.3-0.5 kg per 1,000 kg of paper or pulp. For paper machine washup, use 1.3 L for each 1,000 L of recirculating wash water. Apply the product using a closed delivery system such as a dry coupling and/or metering pump. Do not use in potable water supply.
