DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Product Act. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact of undiluted material with skin. Remove spillage from skin and clothing with warm water and soap. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL & DECONTAMINATION:

Drums may be re-used after thorough cleaning and reconditioning. If not, make the empty container unsuitable for further use and dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.
