FOR INSTITUTIONAL AND INDUSTRIAL USE

F-501 is a combination bacteriostatic-fabric softener for use in laundries in hospitals, nursing homes and diaper plants to aid in controlling the growth of infectious bacteria on fabric. Fabric treated as directed will develop residual bacteriostatic activity against Gram positive (*S. aureus*) organisms and Gram negative (*E. coli*) organisms under conditions of high relative humidity and wet condition. F-501 softens clothes, thus eliminating chafing, "static clings" out of nylons and other synthetics. Improves ironing time.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Use 135 mL (5 oz.) per 45 kg (100 lbs.) of work in the final rinse cycle.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

CAUSES EYE DAMAGE AND SKIN IRRITATION. Do not get into eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Wear chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt and shoes when handling this concentrate.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15- 20 minute. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Remove and launder any contaminated clothing before reusing. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucousal damage may contra-indicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
