DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of insecticides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act. This product is to be used at the rate of 3.00% (wt.) with appropriate solvents, carriers and hydrocarbon propellants in the manufacture of water-base insecticide sprays.
