DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Instructions and Formulation: 3M Chlorpyrifos 20 MEC Microencapsulated Insecticidal Concentrate may be used only for the formulation of an insecticidal product which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Because of their properties and intended uses, formulations containing 3M Chlorpyrifos 20 MEC Microencapsulated Insecticidal Concentrate may require precautionary labeling differing from that given. Formulators should develop their own uses and precautionary labeling based on the properties and intended uses of their own finished formulations.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS - Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and water supplies.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters.

FIRST AID:

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is a preferable antidote. Oximes such as 2-PAM/protopam may be therapeutic if used early, however, use only in conjunction with atropine.

This product contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If lavage is performed, suggest endotracheal and/or oesophageal control. Danger from aspiration must be weighed against toxicity when considering emptying the stomach. If burn is present, treat as any thermal burn, after decontamination.

STORAGE:

Keep in original container during storage. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated place, away from seed, feed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame or other source of heat. Do not contaminate food, feed or water by storage or cleaning of equipment.

DISPOSAL: Canadian formulators of this technical should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill and for clean up of spills.
