Take container, label or product name and PCP Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

Treat symptomatically.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: For best distribution dilute ALGAECIDE 400 in a pail of water and pour around pool. Vacuum to remove dead algae.

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 100 mL of ALGAECIDE 400 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 35 mL of ALGAECIDE 400 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 150 mL of ALGAECIDE 400 per 10,000 L of pool water.
