## **KILLS HORNETS, WASPS, BEES AND OTHER STINGING INSECTS .**

**DIRECTIONS:** Best results are obtained when applications are made in early morning or evening when insects are at rest. STAND WELL AWAY FROM NEST, then spray directly into opening in short 2-3 second blasts so that the spray contacts inside nest entrance. If unable to locate nest, a heavy (residual) spray around and into the openings where insects gain entrance will eventually eliminate the pests. Insects hit by spray or having contacted the sprayed surface will die soon after.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not spray near open flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. DO NOT USE ON HUMANS , PLANTS OR ANIMALS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. Do not spray asphalt shingles, as this product may stain them.

**FIRST AID:** If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. In case of contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Propoxur is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. Do not give morphine. Watch for delayed pulmonary edema in cases of serious poisoning. In this case, use oxygen therapy and treat symptomatically. Contains volatile petroleum distillate.

**DISPOSAL:** When container is empty, press button to release all pressure then dispose in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
