DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

This product should **not** be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since mixtures may be explosive. Do **not** use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. FATAL IF SWALLOWED OR INHALED. CORROSIVE. CAUSES IRREVERSIBLE EYE DAMAGE AND SEVERE SKIN BURNS.

Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear full-face protection, coveralls, chemical-resistant boots when handling the concentrate. Wash hands and face before eating, drinking, smoking and using the toilet. Change clothing daily. Wash contaminated clothing separately from household laundry.

FIRST AID:

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Products Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS:

TOXIC to aquatic organisms. **DO NOT** discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Do not use or store near heat or open flames. BARDAC 2280 QUAT is a cationic germicide. Do not mix with soap or anionic materials.
