DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TCMTB-1030 is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. See Technical Bulletins for directions for use.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Harmful if swallowed. May be harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with clothing, skin, and eyes. When handling the product wear rubber gloves, goggles, and body protective clothing. Causes eye damage. Repeated skin contact may cause skin sensitization to this product. Keep the container closed when not in use. When in use, area should be well ventilated.

Any treated wood is not to be used for constructing food holding containers, food storage facilities or food growing buildings (e.g., mushroom houses).

This product contains a petroleum distillate which is moderately to highly toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of aquatic systems during application. Do not contaminate these systems through direct application, disposal of waste or cleaning equipment.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage. Avoid alcohol.

DISPOSAL
