DIRECTIONS:

Within the specified use location, to enhance effectiveness of this product, apply directly to the listed pests where possible. For all labelled uses, treatment must only be repeated after 7 days if pest problem persists or reoccurs. When applied indoors, good sanitary practices should be maintained to prevent re-infestation.

FOR INDOOR USE AT BUILDINGS:

How to Apply: INDOOR USE: APPLY AS A SPACE SPRAY ONLY. Space spray application is a suspension of fine droplets in the air within an indoor space. To kill flies, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets and spiders, close all windows and doors and shut off all ventilating systems and sources of ignition before treatment. While holding can upright at arm's length, spray upward in sweeping motion to all parts of the room, especially ceiling, upper corners of the room, windows and other light sources. Begin application at far side of the room and work backwards toward exit. DO NOT exceed 3 seconds of spray per 30 m³ of space. Vacate the treated area and keep windows and doors closed for 30 minutes, then ventilate for 30 minutes before re-entry. Following ventilation, clean up dead insects.

FOR OUTDOOR USE AROUND BUILDINGS:

To kill flies, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets and spiders: apply only if air is still and temperature is under 32°C. Hold can upright at arm's length with nozzle pointed away from you. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motions to all areas where insects are congregating including under eaves, around shrubbery, around porches and other areas. DO NOT exceed 15 seconds of spray per 30 m².

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash hands after using. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. DO NOT place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. DO NOT puncture or incinerate can or store at temperatures over 50°C. DO NOT spray into or near any open flame or spark.

Use Limitations for All Uses

DO NOT allow people or pets to enter treated areas until sprays have settled after an indoor space treatment.
DO NOT apply when people or pets are present.
DO NOT remain in treated areas after application.

When applied indoors: Cover or remove all food/feed. Cover all food/feed processing surfaces, equipment and utensils or thoroughly wash them following treatment. Any food/feed accidentally contaminated with spray solution must be discarded. Ventilate treated areas after application by opening windows and doors or using fans, where required, to aid in the circulation of air.

When applied outdoors: DO NOT apply in areas where plants are grown for food or feed (e.g., vegetables, fruit, herbs. DO NOT apply to any body of water. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty.

FIRST AID: If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If accidentally swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Treat symptomatically. Skin exposure may cause transient sensations (tingling, burning, itching, numbness). Other symptoms of exposure could include respiratory effects (such as cough, respiratory irritation, or shortness of breath), nausea, headache or dizziness.
