DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Methylene bis(thiocyanate) is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act. See Technical Bulletins for directions for use.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing and the contamination of food. Wear safety glasses (goggles), rubber gloves and body-protective clothing. **Refer to the Material Safety Data Sheet.**

FIRST AID

Eye exposure: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Skin or clothing exposure: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Inhalation: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Ingestion: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

GIVE FLUIDS BY MOUTH. In all cases, seek immediate medical assistance or contact the Poison Control Centre.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage.

DISPOSAL

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the treatment site.
