**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** To be used only in the manufacture of an insect repellent which is registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.* 

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Causes eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. DO NOT get in eyes. Do not contaminate food or foodstuffs. May have plasticizing or softening action on certain synthetic fibers & paint and lacquer surfaces. May cause skin reactions in sensitive individuals.

## FIRST AID:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

## TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: TREAT SYMPTOMATICALLY.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** In case of a spill or leaking container, prevent personnel exposure by wearing approved personal protective equipment such as impervious clothing, gloves and an organic vapor respirator. Stop the leak and recover the material by placing liquid into another container for recovery or disposal. Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.
