Squeeze out pea sized or smaller portions of paste and deposit behind and under stoves, ovens, refrigerators and freezers, dishwashers, sinks and openings around drains and plumbing, pantries, cabinets, cupboards, closets, washing machines and dryers, bedroom dressers and chests or drawers. Any paste visible after application must be scraped into open cracks and crevices or removed. Reapply as necessary. Avoid contamination of feed of foodstuffs. Use in Non-Food Areas: (Including garbage rooms, rest rooms, laboratories, offices, locker rooms, boiler and equipment rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage): Apply around water and drain pipes, underneath and behind sinks, lockers, tables and similar areas where insects may hide.
