DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a plant growth regulator which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Read technical bulletin for formulation details.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Wear safety goggles when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear an approved respirator when handling large amounts. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Do not contaminate irrigation water, lakes, streams or ponds by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS:

IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IN CASE OF SKIN OR CLOTHING CONTACT, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
